
PASTOR'S ARTICLE

SESSION REPORT

Finances—Discussion on current liquidity of church. Even with the Rainbow Connection Fundraiser the church has had difficulties meeting expenses this summer. The new cross will be installed but will wait on steeple repair until we have a more positive cash flow situation.

PILP has provided temporary mortgage relief for 12 months but in order to refinance with PILP they are requesting a capital debt reduction campaign.

Motion was made and passed to pursue a 20 year refinance with TD Bank.

Motion was made and passed to suspend all special offerings through year end with the exception of 5th Sunday offerings for property care and upkeep.

Motion was made and passed to suspend denominational support for September-December including Per Capita, Presbytery Support, and Theological Educational funding.

Fall on Broadway II plans are underway. Save October 19 for this fun event. God Gab is returning this fall on the 3rd Tuesday starting in September. The new location is Bob Evan's at 6pm.

Movie night will return this fall on September 28.

An outing to La Belle Amie Vineyard is planned for September 28. Contact Carol Butler for more information.

Shepherd Table teams are being aligned for 2020.

Property will pursue painting the sanctuary as funds and timing allow.

A motion was made and passed to have a Congregational Meeting on September 8 to elect church members to serve on the nominating committee.

PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH GOVERNMENT

A major contributor to Reformed theology was John Calvin, who converted from Roman Catholicism after training for the priesthood and in the law. In exile in Geneva, Switzerland, Calvin developed the Presbyterian pattern of church government, which gives governing authority primarily to elected members known as elders. The word Presbyterian comes from the Greek word for elder.

The Presbyterian Church (USA) is governed by councils, which exist to help congregations and the church as a whole be more faithful participants in the mission of Christ. The session is the council for the local congregation and consists of ruling elders and the pastor.

Ruling Elders are elected by the members of the congregation. Together with pastors, or ministers of the Word and Sacrament, they exercise leadership, government, and discipline and have responsibilities for the life of a particular church as well as the church at large, including ecumenical relationships.

Elders are in one sense representatives of the congregation. However, their primary charge is to seek to discover and represent the will of Christ as they govern. Presbyterian elders are both elected and ordained. Through ordination they are officially set apart for service. They retain their ordination beyond their term in office.

The session is the smallest, most local council or governing body. The other governing bodies are presbyteries, which are composed of a number of churches; synods, which are made up of several presbyteries; and the General Assembly, which represents the entire denomination. The session is responsible for governing the congregation and guiding its witness to the sovereign activity of God in the world so that the congregation is and becomes a community of faith, hope, love and witness. In seeking to help the congregation be and become this community, the session has an important role as it engages in prayerful discernment and attends to how God's Spirit may be at work in the congregation and in the broader community.

We recognize that ruling elders are provided "with particular gifts to share in discernment of God's Spirit and governance of God's people" and that "together with teaching elders, exercise leadership, government, spiritual discernment and discipline and have responsibilities for the life a congregation as well as the whole church." (PCUSA Book Of Order)

As it seeks to lead and guide the congregation, the main responsibilities of the session include: 1) Providing the word of God may be truly preached and heard; 2) Providing the Sacraments be rightly administered and received; and 3) Nurturing the covenant community of Christ's disciples.

To give you a better understanding of how our Celebration Presbyterian Church session functions, here are the current session committees: Evangelism, Finance and Stewardship, Missions and Outreach, Christian Education, Hospitality, Personnel, Property, Worship / Media / Web, Endowment, Communication and Technology, Strategic Planning, Preschool Board, and Nominating. Pastor Tom is the Moderator, and our Clerk of Session is Cecilia Evans. Our elders also help to serve Communion and participate in Baptisms. And finally, elders accept and welcome new members into our congregation.
